**IMLS LSTA**, FY 2001. \$650,000. Principal author and project administrator for expansion of InMICH pilot project. Grant provided for purchase of the Innovative Interfaces INN-Reach software, extension of participants to 24 (maintaining goals of geographic diversity, multitype participation, different library automation systems), and demonstration of the NISO Circulation Interchange Protocol (NCIP) for interchange of circulation messages between library systems.

**IMLS LSTA**, FY 1999. \$150,000. Principal author and project administrator for InMICH pilot project to demonstrate the physical union catalog model for a statewide library resource sharing system based on the Innovative Interfaces INN-Reach software. Goals were to explore benefits of a geographically dispersed multitype library consortium with 6 participants, determine feasibility of the physical union catalog model for libraries with different automated library systems, and evaluate three different delivery systems.

**Kellogg.** \$900,000. Contributor to proposal and project coordinator for Kellogg grant to convert 641,465 bibliographic records from manual to machine readable format, 1987-90. Kellogg also made grants at the same time and for the same purpose to the University of Michigan and Wayne State University. These joint efforts form the core of the statewide database of library resources.

**USDE Title II-C.** \$251,982. Principal author and project coordinator for USDE Title II-C project, funded 1983-85, to preserve and provide bibliographic access to Michigan State University's French Monarchy Collection of 9,622 titles.

**Johnson Foundation.** \$8,000.
